The following planning applications were considered:

# DM/0771/16/FUL Humberston Library, Church Lane, Humberston

Retrospective planning permission to change the use of the building into a library (d1) café/restaurant (A3), takeaway including ice cream/pizza (a5) and educational and events premise (D2) with the installation of external wooden pallets to the building

Objections on BBQ being placed in disabled parking area (although not mentioned specifically in description), conversation area concerns with pallets to outside of building, concerns over parking issues and also concerns over unspecified hours for takeaway which should be discussed in liaison with local residents.

### Public Break

Two residents present who were both objecting to application from the Gingerbread House as above. Concerns over reduction in library facility and increase in commercial activities. Ward Cllrs. advised that they would call in the application so that it would be decided by the Planning Committee and not delegated to an Officer.
